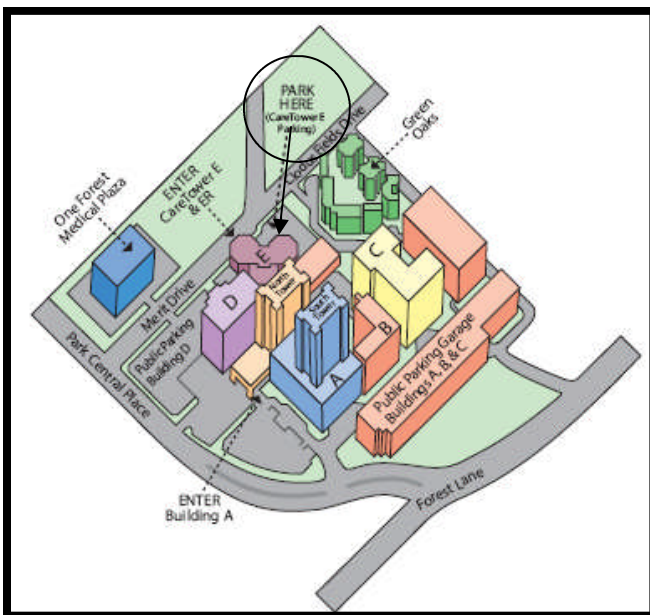
Directions
